Josephine Bakhita responds to her vocation and enters the Religious Life with the Canossian Sisters on December 7, 1893. Three years later she takes her 1st Vows on December 8, 1896 in the presence of Cardinal Sarto. Her first assignment took her to Schio Italy in 1902 where she served most of her Religious Life.

One other assignment was to their Missionary Novitiate from 1935-1939 where she helped prepare the younger candidates for assignments in Africa.

She returned to the convent in Schio and remained there for 42 years where she carried out assignments as cook, sacristan, door keeper and keeping in touch with the local community.

Josephine Bakhita was well known for her virtues of gentleness, her soft and calming voice, her constant smile which gained her the affectionate nick name Sister Moretta translated little brown Sister.

The Sisters in her Community all recognized her beautiful and holy life and made it known in the first publication of her story in 1931. Josephine Bakhita and her saintly life became known throughout Italy.

During the time of World War II her presence provided a calm and sense of protection by the citizens of Schio. The war did pass through the area without a single casualty but it did experience the attacks from the bombs.

At the end of her life she endured much pain and sickness. In some weak and suffering moments she would think back to her days of slavery and call out “the chains are too tight, please loosen them a little for me.”

Finally on a Saturday she spoke her last words calling to the name of our Blessed Lady then became silent. She went home to the Lord on February 8, 1947 at 8:00 pm. According to the records thousands of visitors came to see her and pay their loving and final respects.
